

Hike to view the sunset and moonrise!

Thursday, Oct. 17th, 5:15 p.m.

(RAIN CANCELS!)



This year, October's full moon is known as the Hunters' Moon, and it's a Supermoon! The hike will be a total of 1.5 miles. We'll hike a 1-mile nature trail (with some uphill) through the botanic garden up to our viewing point. We'll sit at the top, have some food, and wait for the sun to set and the moon to rise - scheduled to be just 9 minutes apart! After viewing the Supermoon, we'll finish our hike with just a half-mile walk back to our cars.

Meet at 5:15 (hike starts promptly at 5:30) on Jeanine Drive in Thousand Oaks.

Directions: Use 400 West Gainsborough on your maps app. Go north on Lynn Road, then turn right onto Gainsborough Rd, then turn right onto Jeanine, which is the west entrance into Conejo Community Park. Park near the bathrooms.

BRING: (1) a towel, pad or blanket to sit on
(2) a sandwich or whatever food you want for dinner,
(3) your favorite beverage, and (4) a headlamp or flashlight
